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BEHAVIOR EXPECTATION FORM

Our goal is for each student to experience a Christian community in which they are safe and can grow spiritually and socially, and to ensure that we have a common standard of behavior.

Please read through the guidelines below. Both a parent and the student should sign.

BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS/GUIDELINES

- No drugs, weapons, fighting, game systems, or inappropriate material. If found, the student will be sent home immediately. The parent will be responsible for arranging transportation in the event a student is dismissed from camp.
- No phones during Church group time or any conference sessions.
- No visiting the opposite gender rooms stay in the common area only and do not go in the bedrooms.
- Appropriate swim wear includes one-piece bathing suits for girls, swim trunks and a tank top or t-shirt for boys.
- No public displays of affection.
- Curfew is at 12pm.
- Please show respect to the adult leaders/chaperones.

Parents are responsible for any property damaged or stolen by their student. If any property is damaged or stolen by your student or suspected to have been damaged or stolen by your student, you will be responsible for any payment due.

Parents are also responsible for arranging transportation in the event a student is dismissed from camp. I understand and agree that dismissal from the camp is at the discretion of the student minister and adult leaders, and I will compensate expenses in the case that my student is dismissed from conference. (without reimbursement)
